- For people aged 12-15: They need the consent of their guardian and must be accompanied by their guardian as a rule. Please visit the city's website for required documents such as Maternal and Child Health Handbook.
- For pregnant women who wish to get the vaccine: Make sure to consult family doctor before receiving the vaccine.

Regarding Vaccination for the elderly

The data from the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare shows that the increased vaccination for the elderly may have prevented new infections of more than 100,000 elderly people in July and August and suppressed the deaths of more than 8.000 elderly people.

When do side effects occur?

Side effects usually occur within the first few days of getting the vaccine, but usually go away on their own after a few days. You are more likely to have stronger side effects after a second dose of the vaccine than the first dose.



Please decide for yourself whether to get vaccinated, understanding both the effectiveness in preventing infection and the risk of side effects.

☐ If you have symptoms such as fever in everyday life, first consult a family doctor or a familiar medical institution.
☐ If you do not have a family doctor, or have any of the following, please consult the
Consultation Centers mentioned below.
- Difficulty breathing, strong fatigue, or a high fever.
- Those who are at high risk to develop severe symptoms of COVID-19, and have a fever

Households that have borrowed the additional temporary loan from the general support fund (COVID-19 Special Loan), etc. are eligible to receive support benefit.

Subsidy for Students Attending Schools for Foreign Residents in Japan

A parent or guardian of a student who is attending a school for foreign residents in Japan (equivalent to Japanese elementary or junior high schools) may be eligible for school attendance subsidy.

- Eligibility: Those who satisfy both of the following two conditions:
 - A parent or guardian of a foreign student or pupil who was born between April 2, 2006 and April 1, 2015 and attends a school for foreign residents in Japan (equivalent to Japanese elementary or junior high schools)
 - A resident of Ashiya as of October 1, 2021, who is receiving Child Allowance (excluding Special Benefits)
 - * Those who received a school attendance subsidy as of fiscal year 2016 are eligible.

Supplementary Allowance for Pensioners

Since late August, claim forms have been sent out to those eligible for Supplementary Allowance for Pensioners (年金生活者支援給付金 nenkin seikatsusha shien kyufukin). This allowance is available to supplement the pension benefits of those whose income from public pension and other incomes are below a certain level. Please be sure to return the claim forms by the end of the year, as you must submit a claim to receive the allowance (in principle, a claim is not required after the second year).

- ◆ Supplementary Allowance for Old-age Pensioners

- > Those who satisfy all of the following conditions:

 - All members of the household are exempt from municipal resident tax,
 - The combined income of pension benefits and any other income is approximately 880,000 yen or below.

Appearance Support for Cancer Patients

To help improve the quality of life of cancer survivors by reducing anxiety associated with appearance changes, the purchase costs of prosthetic devices, medical wigs, and breast prostheses may be subsidized. Applications are accepted starting October 1, 2021.

- ♦ Eligibility: Ashiya city citizens who have been diagnosed with cancer, who have undergone or are undergoing treatment, and who have purchased prosthetic devices mentioned below on or after April 1, 2021 (income restrictions apply).

 - ➤ Breast prostheses 10,000 yen for prosthetic bras or 50,000 yen for artificial breast forms (one prosthesis per person)

Revision of Minimum Wage Rates

Effective October 1, 2021, the minimum hourly wage in Hyogo Prefecture is now 928 yen (previously 900 yen). The new minimum wage rate applies to all workers, including those who work part-time or as a student "arbeit."




