

Settsu Meisho Zue

During the Edo period (1603-1867), illustrated travel guidebooks of various regions were produced to introduce famous sceneries and historic sites, including "Settsu Meisho Zue" published in 1796. Settsu Province was located in the current northern part of Osaka City and the southeast of Hyogo Prefecture.

The village of Uchide at that time is introduced and Abo Shinnozuka Mound (The Mound of Prince Abo), Kanatsuyama *Kofun* and Uchide Beach are featured as famous places in Uchide

Promenade through History - Uchide -

There are a number of historical sites around the Hanshin Uchide Station. Wouldn't you like to enjoy walking northward from the Station to feel the history of the area?

⟨Saigoku Kaido Historic Road along which the Daimyo procession passed⟩

Ashiya area has been a main road connecting the capital, Kyoto, and Dazaifu Shrine in Kyushu. The road was called Sanyo Road in ancient times and Saigoku Road in the Edo period. Saigoku literally means "western countries". At Uchide, near the border with Nishinomiya, it branched off to the northern Main Road which runs along the Naruo Mikage Road in present Kasuga-cho and Uchidekozuchi-cho, and then branched off to the southern Beach Road which is now ROUTE 2 in Miyazuka-cand Chayano-cho.

In the Edo period, this Highway was used by daimyo (feudal lords) in procession to and from Edo (now Tokyo) and various domains in western Japan. Uchide was named after the place where people who travelled westward along the Saigoku Road came out (uchideru), and had a view of the sea here for the first time after they left Kyoto.

<The Legend of Prince Abo>

Both routes merge at Ikuta Shrine in Kobe.



There is a stone monument of "Abo Shinnozuka Mound" on the sidewalk along the Naruo Mikage Road. It is a stone monument that guides passersby on the Saigoku Road to the Abo Shinnozuka in Midorigaoka-cho. On the side of the monument is inscribed the name of Emperor Heijo's fourth son and "5 cho", indicating that if you go north 5 cho, you will reach Abo Shinnozuka. (5cho=545m).

It is said that he was the father of the famous poet, Ariwara no Narihira (825–880). However, archeological research has revealed that the tomb is actually that of a local powerful family

that ruled the Hanshin area in the early Kofun period.

In the Edo period, the Mori clan of Choshu, who revered Prince Abo as their ancestor, maintained this mound and donated a stone lantern. More than 8 bronze mirrors were excavated as burial accessories, four of which are kept at Abo Shinnoji Temple and are designated as cultural assets by Ashiya City.

The Kanatsuyama *Kofun* located in Kasuga-cho is an ancient Keyhole-shaped burial mound dating from the first half of the 5th century. Only the rear part of the tumulus remains as the front part was cut away during the development of fields from the 12th to 14th century. Legend has it that Prince Abo buried gold in this mound for the villagers in case they were in trouble.

There is another burial mound in this vicinity, the Uchidekozuchi *Kofun* which was all but obliterated



by development during the Muromachi period (1336–1573) and no trace of remains above ground. However, excavations have revealed the remains of a ditch and many pieces of *haniwa*(clay figures) indicating that the burial mound was 60 meters long and built at the end of the 5th century. It is thought that a member of a powerful family related to the person buried in the Kanatsuyama *kofun* may have been buried here. These two burial mounds were built on the Midorigaoka Plateau, which forms the topography of Uchide area, and it is thought

this plateau was a sacred place suitable for the burial of a powerful family.

<Modernism in the Hanshin area>



Uchide Branch Library

The Matsuyama family's mansion was located where the Uchide Branch Library and Kozuchi Kindergarten are now located. The owner, Mr. Matsuyama, owned a business dealt in safes and Buddhist altar articles. The main building near the kindergarten was destroyed by fire in the Hanshin Air Raid of 1945, but the stone building that housed art works remains and is now used as a branch of the library. The building was relocated and reconstructed from a bank on Midosuji Street in Osaka in 1930, and in 2008 it was designated as the nationally registered Tangible Cultural Property. The stone wall of the east side of the site and the Japanese garden at the Uchide

Educational and Cultural Center are also remnants of the mansion.

<The Oldest site in the Hanshin Area?>

The history of Uchide area dates back to the Old Stone Age, about 20,000 years ago. At that time the sea level was more than 100m lower than today. The coastline had extended even further the Kitan Strait. Osaka Bay did not exist. Ashiya was located far inland from the coast. The Uchidekozuchi site, which lies beneath the ground in Uchidekozuchi-cho, has yielded knife-shaped stone tools dating back to about 20,000 years ago It indicates that Ashiya has been inhabited since the Old Stone Age. This is the oldest archaeological site not only in Ashiya but also in the Hanshin area.

Information about COVID-19 Vaccination

(This information is accurate as of April 24, 2022.)

Booster Shots (3rd dose)

The eligibe age for additional vaccinations has been lowered to 12 years old. Those aged 12 or older can receive booster shots at least six months after receiving their second dose.

■ For children aged 12-17

Pfizer's COVID-19 vaccine booster shots are approved for those aged 12-17.

Takeda/Moderna vaccine is unavailable for those people.

The period to send out the vaccination voucher

The vaccination voucher will be sent out to those eligible approx. ten days before six months have passed since their second shot. If you have received two doses of the COVID-19 vaccine overseas, or if you don't receive your booster voucher even after your vaccination period has passed, please apply by using the 2D code on the right or contact Ashiya City COVID-19 Vaccine Call Center.



Vaccination schedule

- Inoculation at Health and Welfare Center was completed on Sun., May 1.
- If you wish to get vaccinated, please make a reservation as early as possible at individual medical facilities.

For children aged 5-11 (1st & 2nd dose)

Vaccination for children aged 5-11 has started.

- COVID-19 vaccination is not mandatory. Please decide for yourself whether your child will get vaccinated, understanding both the effectiveness in preventing infection and possible side effects.
- Each month children who are turning 5 will receive their voucher around the 20th of the month before their birthday month.
- Anyone aged 12 and older is still eligible to receive the first shot.
- For children aged 15 and younger who receive the first or booster shot

Things to bring: *vaccination voucher *pre-vaccination screening questionnaire

- ID of the child who receives a shot Parental consent
- ·Maternal and Child health handbook ·ID of the guardian



*The child must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Please take the following measures:


- ▶ Reduce garbage and use crow repelling nets to cover outside garbage dumps.

We will Provide University Entrance Exam Fees for Those with Financial Hardship



Ashiya City University Admission Support Fund





This fund was founded on the basis of donations from late Ms. ARAMAKI Shizuko, in line with her wishes that no one, with the desire to learn, must give up going to university because of financial hardship. Now we are implementing the two systems: "Ashiya City University Entrance Exam Fee Support Payment System" (芦屋市大学等受験料支援金制度) and "Ashiya City University Admission Preparation Allowance System" (芦屋市大学等入学支度金制度).

[Ashiya City University Entrance Exam Fee Support Payment System]

- Eligibility: Persons who fit all of the following conditions
 - (1) Having lived in Ashiya city for one year or longer at the time of application
 - (2) Aiming to take the exam to enter a university (a university/ a junior college/ a technical college) in fiscal year 2022.
 - (3) Having applied for the national "New system of study support for higher education" and having been acknowledged in Category 1.
- Amount of provision: Up to 100,000 yen /Up to 3 exams (Up to 35,000 yen per exam)
- Application: Apply to the Management section of Board of Education from October 2022.
 * One person can make an application only once.

(Furusato Kifu: Hometown tax donation system)

[Q & A on "Ashiya City University Entrance Exam Fee Support Payment System"]

- Q: Is there anything I need to prepare before application?
- A: Be sure to apply for the national "New system of study support for higher education", as acknowledgement of "Being in Category 1 in the system" is required for the application.
- Q: Are there any documents or papers required for the application?
- A: Prepare the following documents:



- (1) Application form for "Ashiya City University Entrance Exam Fee Support Fund"
- (2) Documents showing that you have been acknowledged in Category 1 in the national "New system of study support for higher education", (3) A copy of exam admission ticket, (4) Papers (copies of brochure or webpage, etc.) showing the amount of exam fees and (5) Papers (copies of receipts, etc.) showing the completion of exam fees transfer
- Q: Is it possible for a student who failed in entrance exam to apply?
- A: It is possible as long as it is within 2 years of graduating from a high school. It is necessary that the student is acknowledged in Category 1 in the national "New system of study support for higher education".
- Q: Is a vocational school eligible for this system?
- A: Universities, etc. as stipulated in Article 1 of School Education Law are eligible; vocational schools are not eligible.
- Q: Are university correspondence courses eligible for this system?
- A: University correspondence courses stipulated in Article 1 of School Education Law are eligible.
- Q: Is the Common Test for University Admission eligible for payment?
- A: Totaled amount of exam fees of the Common Test for University Admission and other exams which utilize the Common Test will be paid as the fee for one exam
- Q: Is the exam fee of a university that rejected the applicant eligible for payment?
- A: It is eligible for payment regardless of the result, pass or fail.
- Q: I could not apply for the national "New system of study support for higher education" before the exam. Can I apply for "Ashiya City University Entrance Exam Fee Support Fund"?
- A: If you are to apply in the next fiscal year (after admission), there may be some cases where you can apply only within the fiscal year of admission.

To All the New Adults: Beware of Consumption Troubles!

From April 1, 2022, Age of Majority has been lowered from 20 to 18.

When you reach adulthood, you can sign various contracts without your guardian's consent (Purchase of a smartphone, making a credit card, rent of an apartment house for living alone, etc.). Once a contract has been made, it cannot be revoked. You should consider carefully if it is really necessary before making a contract to avoid getting into trouble.

[My Number Card On-Site Application]

City staff will visit groups or organizations who wish to apply for My Number Card, will take a photo for application and accept applications free of charge. Please use this service for those who have difficulty coming to the City Hall, etc.

[Myna Points]

Those who have got My Number Card and have not applied for Myna Points at the end of September 2022 can receive up to 5,000 Yen worth of points for recharging or shopping. There are some cashless payment services which require procedures separately.

FY 2022 Total Exemption from Light Vehicle Tax (Category Base)

People with disabilities are exempt from light vehicle tax (category base) or automobile tax (category base) for one vehicle.

- Eligibility: A light vehicle which is owned by someone who is registered disabled as of April 1st, or by a person who shares a home and livelihood with the disabled person, and corresponds to any of the following criteria:
 - The disabled person drives the light vehicle themselves.
 - The person who shares the livelihood with a disabled person drives the light vehicle for the disabled person.
 - The person who constantly cares for a household consisting only of a disabled person drives the light vehicle for the disabled person.

-Extension of Application DeadlineA Self-reliance Support Benefit for Households Suffering Financially from the COVID-19 Pandemic

Households that have finished the additional loan from the Emergency Small Loan /General Support Fund (COVID-19 Special Loan) are eligible to receive the support benefit.

- Eligible Household: Household that corresponds to any of the following criteria: [Initial (Those who have not received the grant)]
 - ◆ Having finished the first loan from the Emergency Small Loan or the General Support Fund (COVID-19 Special Loan) or June being the last month of borrowing
 - Having finished the additional loan from the General Support Fund (COVID-19 Special Loan)

*For the households for which the last month of borrowing has not arrived yet, application should be made in the last month of borrowing.

[Re-grant]

- Those who meet the requirements of job-searching and reporting in every month during the initial support period (3 months)
- * There are separate requirements for income, assets and job-searching activities, etc. to receive support.
- Monthly Allowance: 60,000 yen for one person household / 80,000 yen for a 2-person household / 100,000 yen for a household of 3 or more members
- Payment Period: 3 months (Initial) / 3months (Re-grant); (Up to 6 months)

Authorization is Required to Repaint Exterior Walls

When painting exterior walls for new construction or as part of renovation work, etc., you need to apply for the prior authorization under the Landscape Law to ensure conformity with coloration standards in place.

The entire city of Ashiya is designated as either an Ashiya Landscape District or Ashiyagawa Special Landscape District. Coloration standards for exterior walls and roofs of homes are in place to protect the beautiful landscape of Ashiya City.

The authorization process takes approximately two weeks. No fee is required.


