

The following articles are taken mainly from "Koho Ashiya" – the bulletin of Ashiya City (December issue). It is, of course, a Japanese edition, and translated into English by a voluntary group from the Ashiya Cosmopolitan Association.

Ashiya City has been implementing the "Ashiya City Friendly Store Project" in order to increase the number of stores that people with disabilities can easily use. These stores try to be as considerate as possible towards people with disabilities and support their participation in society.

Ashiya - a City conscious of Gentleness (Abridged)

We talked to Ms. Hagiwara, the manager of Par-ty, a beauty salon registered as "Friendly Store in Ashiya" and she explained how she and the staff treat and handle their customers.

When did you start welcoming customers with disabilities?

- We did not start to do anything special. Since the time of the owner before last, the founder of the beauty salon, we had customers in wheelchairs, so we had tried to create a barrier- free salon. Some of them have been coming for a long time and some are older and in wheel-chairs. We just want them to have a good time. We want customers to leave with a smile.

How do you accommodate people with disabilities?

- One of the staff is certified as a helper, so we share the knowledge and experience. For example, when a customer in a wheelchair needs to move to a chair for washing his/her hair, he can move smoothly when we hold a part of the wheelchair. However, some people need help and some don't, so we respect each person's wishes. It is sometimes difficult to communicate with children with developmental disabilities, so we give them as many choices as possible: Do you prefer this style or that style? Many of them come with their mothers but sometimes parents and children want different hair styles. We can make suggestions that are a compromise between the opinions of both.

We have heard that they have had negative things said about them at other salons and that they have become too worried about other customers. We encourage them to put their own wishes first and I try to speak slowly with a smile. For children who are here for the first time, I try to talk in depth about what interests them. If they have a mascot on their bag, do they like that character? Some find it difficult to voice to their thoughts, so we wait for them to speak first and we don't show any impatience.

To establish a relationship of trust at the outset is the utmost important. We are also able to provide written communication.

Please give a message to people with disabilities?

- I have heard that people with disabilities are hesitant to go out.

Please come and let me talk to you first, either in person or by phone.

We can offer you a nice hairstyle that is easy to maintain at home.

I hope you will have the courage to take the first step.

What kind of city do you hope Ashiya will become in the future?

- Customers say Ashiya is a clean and comfortable place to live and I agree. However, there are still some stores that are difficult to enter if you are in a wheelchair or with a small child. It would be very nice to hear that it is okay to enter with a wheelchair or it is okay

for a child to cry. The POP (Point of Purchase Advertising) of the "Ashiya City Friendly Store" can be a good alternative to such a voice. If this POP is well known and understood, people will be able to enter without hesitation. I hope that the number of such friendly stores will increase and Ashiya will become a friendly town.

If you register, we will post that information on our official website and make it known to citizens. The registered stores will be issued "Ashiya City Friendly Store for Everyone" POP that reflects the contents of the registration.





"Reasonable accommodation" obligatory from April 2024

When a person with a disability requests some kind of accommodation, //
stores or business staff must provide "reasonable accommodation" to the extent that it is
not too burdensome.

Subsidy available

Ashiya City subsidizes a part of the cost for stores and other facilities to provide reasonable accommodation. For example, the subsidy covers the cost of installing handrails in stores and preparing communication tools: Braille menus, leaflet with voice code, etc.



Subsidies for Expenses for School Supplies

Information about the COVID-19 Vaccination (As of Nov. 16)

Temporary vaccinations for COVID-19 are scheduled to end at the end of March, 2024. Please consider receiving vaccination as soon as possible.

Autumn 2023 Start Vaccination (Vaccine for Omicron strain, XBB1.5)

Vaccinations against the Omicron XBB strain are available now.

- Target persons: Persons aged 6 months or over who have completed the initial
- vaccinations and three months have passed since their previous vaccination * The vaccination starting autumn 2023 is not obligatory, however, it is strongly advised for the elderly aged 65 and over, or those with underlying medical conditions or whose doctors decide they are high risk of developing severe symptoms. Please consider the effects and side effects of the vaccination before you decide whether or not to have the
- vaccination.
- Type of vaccine used: Monovalent vaccine for Omicron strain, XBB1.5



Over 6 years of age: Pfizer and Moderna vaccine Under 5 years of age: Pfizer vaccine

- *The type of vaccine used differs depending on the age of target persons.
- *Regarding the effectiveness of the COVID-19 vaccine, it has been reported that the effect of preventing infection and onset of the disease lasts for about 2-3 months, and the effect of preventing the disease from becoming more severe lasts for more than a year,
- ■Vaccination period: Until the end of March, 2024
- ■Vaccination coupon: The vaccination coupon will be mailed to those eligible approx. ten days before three months have passed since their previous shot. If you have already received a coupon and did not use it, please use the coupon for the vaccination.
- ■How to make an appointment: Make an appointment at individual medical institutions.
- If it is difficult to connect to each medical institution by phone, please wait for a while before making your reservation.
- *Appointment method may vary depending on each medical institution.
- *Please check medical institutions on the city's website (2D code).

Application for Partial Provision of Yearly Total of High-priced Outpatient Medical Care Cost

When copayment (cost of individual payment) for outpatient medical care exceeds a certain amount, the excess will be refunded.

- Eligibility: Those who are insured by National Health Insurance (70 years or older) or by Medical Care for the Elderly and correspond to all of the following conditions:
 - Having an income classification of mid to low as of July 31, 2023.
 - Copayment for outpatient medical care between August, 2022 and July, 2023 exceeds 144,000 yen.

Make a Report if You Had a Traffic Accident "Notification of Injury and Illness Caused by a Third Party Act"

If you were injured by the ways written below and use your insurance card for medical costs, you need to make a report "Notification of injury and illness caused by a third party act" to your health insurer.

- Injury caused by a traffic accident with another party
- Injury, such as being bitten by a stranger's pet / Injuries sustained in violent acts like fighting / Food poisoning at restaurants, etc.

Do you know? : System of Notification to the Individual

When a certificate such as a copy of resident card or family register of an individual has been issued to a third party, the individual receives notification in this system. It prevents improper billing or human right violation. Registration is required to receive the notification; you must register!



Ashiya School Lunch Recipes ■ Chocolate Pudding ☐ Ingredients (serves 4) > Jello Topping 25 g chocolate 6 g agar-agar powder 400 g milk 40 g sugar 200 ml water 5 g agar-agar powder 'canned fruit, if desired 36 g sugar 20 g cocoa powder ☐ Directions: ➤ Make Chocolate Pudding 1. Chop chocolate and melt it in a double boiler. 2. Mix agar powder, sugar, and cocoa powder together thoroughly. 3. Heat milk in a saucepan to about 85°C, then add the powder mixture (2.) all at once, stirring well. 4. Pour and mix the melted chocolate into the saucepan and turn off the heat. Strain the mixture through a sieve or colander into cups or containers. Once they cool to room temperature, refrigerate to chill. ➤ Make Jello Topping 1. Mix agar powder and sugar thoroughly. 2. Heat water in a saucepan to about 85°C, then add the powder mixture all at once, stirring well. Pour into a flat container, cool to room temperature, and refrigerate to chill. 3. Once it has set, break up the jello with a fork. 4. Place the crushed jello on top of the set chocolate pudding. You can also add canned fruit to your liking.
